None of these are details yet, they are just ideas that we are considering. None of these ideas are proposed for all of the money, we will most likely end up considering and spending it on a range of options.

Idea	Ranking 1-10	Notes
Installation of a glass front door so that we can keep the door closed but remain welcoming on Sunday mornings and at other times when we are open.		
Employment of a children and families worker / youth worker to support engagement with the community.		
Investment of some of the money into an ethical fund that supports micro-loans or similar. This money would then be available to spend as and when we need it.		
Installation of toilets and kitchenette in the Sunday School and lobby area – this would facilitate the independence of this room, both for our own use and for any bookings that use the room.		
Addition of a cross onto the church roof above the porch door and / or on the Chessel Street entrance.		
New noticeboard on the corner of Chessel Street and Aubrey Road.
